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SDOH Screening Tools: Adults

- **PRAPARE**

- Screening tool for use by health centers to identify, understand and respond to adult patients' needs
- Developed by National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC)

- **Roots to Health Survey**

- Screening tool to assess unmet basic adult needs for use in healthcare settings
- Developed by The Civic Engine

- Screening tool to assess social needs that can affect a patient's health (food insecurity, housing instability, utility needs, financial resource strain, transportation & violence)

SDOH Screening Tools: Children

- **Safe Environment for Every Kid (SEEK)**
 - Validated screening tool to identify risk factors for child maltreatment for primary care practices (ages birth-5 years)
 - Developed by University of Maryland

- **Well-child Care visit, Evaluation, Community Resources, Advocacy, Referral, Education (WE-CARE)**
 - Screening tool to assess psychosocial issues at well-child visits in medical clinics

Protocol for Responding to and Assessing Patients' Assets, Risks, and Experiences **(PRAPARE)**

– Tool to help health centers assess and respond to patients' social determinants of health

– PRAPARE

- Can be administered by various staff members
- Can be administered on paper and integrates with 4 EHRs (Epic, NextGen, Centricity, and eClinicalWorks)
- Is being translated into multiple languages
